Who regulates mobile telecommunications in Venezuela?

Mobile telecommunications in Venezuela are regulated by CONATEL (Comisi3n Nacional de Telecomunicaciones), which oversees the licensing and operation of mobile operators. The market is characterized by a mix of state-owned and private entities. There are three main mobile operators; Digitel, Movilnet and Movistar.

Does Venezuela have a telecommunications market?

Venezuela, despite facing economic and political challenges in recent years, has a dynamic telecommunications market. Mobile operators play a pivotal role in keeping citizens connected, providing essential services amid an increasingly digital world.

How did Digitel expand its network in Venezuela?

Digitel's network originally only covered Venezuela's central region, but the company expanded its reach through a series of mergers and network expansion programs. In 2013, Digitel became the first operator in Venezuela to offer 4G/LTE capabilities in major cities.
