The Vatican on Wednesday signed an agreement with German carmaker Volkswagen to replace the city-state's entire car fleet with electric vehicles by 2030.

The city-state plans to gradually replace its existing cars with electric vehicles. Volkswagen is the Vatican's chosen partner for the project, which will start at the beginning of 2024.

Vatican City has expanded its electric mobility initiative with the acquisition of 14 new electric vehicles, reinforcing its ambitious 'Ecological Conversion 2030' program.

With this new delivery, the Governorate's commitment to gradually replacing its cars with electric vehicles continues, with the aim of making the car fleet zero-impact by 2030.

The Vatican City State intends "to make its car fleet carbon neutral by 2030" by replacing all its vehicles with electric ones, it announced in a press release on November 15, 2023.
