The Georgetown Steam Plant was in large part an expensive exercise in preparedness, built only to add incrementally to the Seattle Electric Company's capacity during periods of heavy ...

Once at the center of the rapidly growing Georgetown neighborhood, the Georgetown Steam Plant was built by the Seattle Electric Company in 1906-1907 on 18 acres of land along the Duwamish River.

The power plant was commissioned in 2000 and started energy production the same year. The current owner and operator of the Georgetown facility is Indianapolis Power & Light Co.
