This rate plan has two pricing levels, known as &quot;tiers,&quot; which are based on how much energy you use. Energy used within your Baseline Allowance is Tier 1 and billed at the lowest price.

On January 1, 2026, residential electric rates will decrease about 5% for customers who get both electricity supply and delivery service from PG& E, compared to current rates.
