Digicel Tonga launches 5G, unlocking faster connectivity for Dec 5, 2024 &#183; Digicel Tonga has launched its first six 5G sites, marking a milestone for the country's digital transformation.

With over 80,000 cellular subscribers and 5,000 fixed broadband users, TCC plays a critical role in Tonga's connectivity. TCC began its IPv6 journey in 2009, acquiring a /36 IPv6 allocation from APNIC. The ...

Tonga Communications Corporation (TCC) and Digicel Tonga have both launched their commercial 5G networks. The two telcos launched their respective networks within a week of each other.

On 15 January 2022, following a volcanic eruption on the island of Hunga Tonga-Hunga Ha'apai, the Tonga Cable System was severed, leaving the country without Internet access.

Today, it dominates 100% market share on fixed telephone lines, 70% market share on dial up and broadband internet, over 50% marketshare of GSM mobile services (branded UCall mobile), employs over 300 people, ...

There are two telecommunications network operators in Tonga, namely, Digicel and TCC. Digicel Tonga (formerly TonFon) is a privately owned company and Tonga Communications Corporation (TCC) is a state ...

TCC provides fixed line, mobile and internet services in Tonga. While fixed line growth is reasonably static, growing by just 2% in 2015, mobile phone subscriptions increased by 16% over the same period.
