In line with Kosovo's current focus of transitioning towards an energy future that is more sustainable, inclusive, reliable, and affordable, the Kosovo Compact focuses on addressing Kosovo's unreliable supply of electricity, a binding economic constraint for the country, through three projects.

Is Kosovo a democratic country?

Kosovo is a young, vibrant democracy in the Balkan Peninsula of Southeastern Europe with visible commitments to democratic values and institutions and investing in its citizens. Kosovo was selected to develop a \$202 million compact program in December 2018 while the country continued to implement an ongoing threshold program.
